This edition of the International Journal of Serious Games is mostly dedicated to a special issue on "Gamification of Industrial Systems", guest edited by Samir Garbaya and Theo Lim [1]. The special issue aims at investigating new emerging needs for gamification in industry. The issue features six articles, that address important challenging issues through conducting pilot studies and developing gamified industrial applications.

The issue is completed by a regular paper, that I briefly introduce in the following.

"FarMyo: A Serious Game for Hand and Wrist Rehabilitation Using a Low-Cost Electromyography Device", by Batista et Al. [2], shows the development of a serious game focused on aiding the rehabilitation process of patients with hand motor problems, targeting to solve problems related to cost, adaptability and patient motivation in this type of application. The game uses an electromyography device to recognize the gestures being performed by the user. A gesture recognition system was developed to detect new gestures, complementing the device's own recognition system, which is responsible for interpreting the signals. An initial evaluation of the game was conducted with professional physiotherapists.
